- I. The teaching of Jesus regarding the demands of ministry (vv. 30-44).
 - A. Jesus taught his disciples to make periods of rest a priority in ministry (vv. 30-32).
 - 1. The time of rest was after a period of labor (v. 30).
 - The place of rest was in a place of solitude (v. 31a).
 - 3. The reason for rest was to replenish strength (vv. 31b-32).
 - B. Periods of rest preceded more ministry (vv. 33-44, 52).
 - 1. The place of ministry was on the shore ahead of Jesus and the Apostles (v. 33).
 - 2. The kind of ministry was compassion toward lost people (v. 34).
 - 3. The purpose of ministry was to grow the faith of the Apostles during a time of need (vv. 35-44, 52).
 - a. The Apostles did not have the power to feed the many people (vv. 35-37).
 - Jesus demonstrated the power to feed the many people (vv. 38-44).
 - 1. The source of Jesus power was the Father in heaven (vv. 38-41).
 - The result of Jesus power was the miracle to feed the multitude (vv. 42-44).
 - c. The desired response to the power of Christ is faith (v. 52).

 - A. We must make rest a priority
 - 1. After a period of labor
 - 2. In a place of solitude
 - 3. In order to replenish our strength
 - 4. Because the promise of more ministry
 - a. The place of ministry is ahead of us in our homes, jobs and church
 - b. The kind of ministry is compassion
 - c. The purpose of our ministry is to grow our faith
 - 1. We cannot do it in our own strength
 - 2. Only Jesus can do the impossible
 - 3. We must learn to trust Jesus more
