Another Quiz season in the books!

We just returned from the Bible Quiz Fellowship National Competition in Wisconsin. What a trip! This was the first time I had traveled by air since February 2019 when we flew to Jamaica for our mission trip. Things have changed! But I don't want to dwell on that. Instead I want to share with you that we finished 6th out of 29 teams in the tournament! Thank you for your prayers!

Each morning I had the privilege of sharing God's Word with the quizzers and parents of our team. We spent all of our time in Psalm 79:13. This verse tells us of our position in Gods family. We are His people and the sheep of His pasture. Then the last two phrases tell us what we should be doing in response to our position. We should "give thanks" and "recount your praise from generation to generation." It would be very hard to give thanks to someone we don't even know or to recount something that we can't remember.

To be able to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with people we must first know Him ourselves. We must belong to Him through faith, receiving Him into our lives as our Lord and Savior. Then we are to share this Good News with others by reminding them what God has done. Remembering plays a key role in both of these. This is why we use this tool called Bible quizzing to help students learn to memorize God's Word so that they will grow in their relationship with Jesus and will be able to remember the truth of His word when they are sharing the Good News with others.
